Tim Tudor, of Muskogee, passed away Tuesday, February 23, 2021 at Saint Francis Hospital of Tulsa at the age of 67. He was born June 15, 1953 in Tulsa, OK to Jack L. Tudor Sr. and Betty Grider.

Tim served in the Air Force from July 1972 until October 1976 as an Aircraft Mechanic. He attended Muskogee High School through his junior year. He then went to Rich Hill High School located in Rich Hill, MO and graduated in 1971.

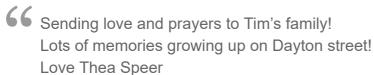
