After High School she went to Tulsa and enrolled in the nursing program at Hillcrest Memorial Hospital where she would spend the next 3 years. They were married in 1954 in Muskogee at the home of Bill and Ruth.

Once married the couple moved to New York where their 3 children Donna, Nancy and David were born.

In 1964 the family moved to Miami, and then Sebring in 1980.

Helen loved her family and took great pride in her grandchildren Matthew, Daniel, Pamela, Andrew, Eric, Dayne, Christopher and Ashley. One of the joys of old age was becoming an "Oma"(great grandmother) to Meredith, Michelle, Davis, Emily, Ethan, Matthew, Alli, Lillian and Hyyette.
