

## Mildred Noblin Henderson

August 10, 1925 - January 6, 2021

Mildred Louise Noblin Henderson, 95, of Muskogee, passed away peacefully at her residence on January 6, 2021 with her family by her side. She was born on August 10, 1925 at the Watts Ranch in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma.
