Albert Henry Thomas, 82, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully on August 12, 2025. He was born on January 10, 1943, in Henryetta, Oklahoma, to James Albert Thomas and Lorene (Elledge) Thomas.

Albert graduated from East Central University in Ada and then served six years in the Army Reserve. After graduation, he began working in Washington, DC, for the GAO office before transferring to Denver, Colorado. He later moved to Muskogee and worked at the VA Hospital as the chief fiscal officer for 40 years.

His strong and enduring faith in Christ was one of the fundamental aspects of his life. He served as an elder and Church Treasurer at Bethany Presbyterian Church. He also volunteered with Meals on Wheels and was involved in the Backpack Program.
