Before she left the area, she spent many years as administrative secretary at Okmulgee Memorial Hospital where she put her shorthand and typing skills to task.

Ruth loved to garden, was a great seamstress, cook, and baker. She made the best yeast rolls you could possible eat along with her cinnamon rolls, two

items always on the menu for holidays and special occasions.
