Austin Charles Warwick, of Muskogee, OK, passed away suddenly on January 24th, 2023 at the age of 28.

Austin was born June 25th, 1994 in Minneapolis, MN to DeLaine Warwick and Michael Hancock.

He attended Muskogee High School, then went on to earn a diploma in Non-Destructive Testing from Spartan College of Aeronautics and Technology. Austin graduated from Spartan with honors in September of 2014. At the time of his death, he was pursuing an engineering degree and working in construction.

Austin met his wife Laynnye in 2010 at Muskogee High School and remained committed to her for the rest of his life. The couple were married October 17th, 2020 at Sequoyah State Park in Hulbert, OK. They were inseparable and could very rarely be found without each other, even after 13 years together.

Austin was always a musician and could play any instrument he picked up. He was adventurous and loved travelling and watersports. He was a proud husband who enjoyed spoiling Laynnye to her heart's content. Austin was incredibly creative and was known amongst his friends for inventing games on a whim. He never knew a moment of silence and life absolutely followed him anywhere he went.

Austin was saved six years ago at New Life Center Church and avidly attended services on Wednesdays and Sundays. He often sought comfort

within his Bible, especially in Psalms and Proverbs.

Austin is survived by his wife, Laynnye; his parents, DeLaine Warwick and Michael Hancock; his in-laws, Cindy and Jake Mariano; his grandparents, Bob and Sue Warwick, his grandmother, Lois Dahoud, and his grandmother, Sherrye Justus.
