Billy Eric Jordan was born September 18, 1946, in Moffett, OK to Steve and Billie Ruth Jordan. He was the 4th of Steve and Billie Ruth's 11 children. Billy grew up in Muskogee, Oklahoma and graduated from Central High School with the Class of 1964. At 19 years old, he proudly enlisted in the U.S. Army and volunteered for Vietnam. Serving as a truck driver from 1965 to 1968, Billy completed his service and was honorably discharged at the rank of SP4.

After returning home, Billy was blessed with two sons, Jimmy and Monte, whom he loved deeply and raised with care and pride. He worked for over 35 years at J&S Paper Company, and after retiring, he continued doing what he loved—driving trucks—for Winfield United. Billy never considered his time at Winfield a job because he truly enjoyed it.

Family was everything to "Papa Bill." He cherished his wife of 18 years, Randy, and together they shared countless adventures. Billy embraced Randy's family as his own and was a constant source of love and laughter.
