Cas William Walters, Jr., 86, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, October 13, 2015. He was born March 6, 1929 to Cas William Walters, Sr. and Lois Thelma (Clopton) Walters in Fort Smith, Arkansas. Cas attended Franklin Grade School, West High Jr High School, and graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1947.

He then attended Muskogee Jr. College.

Cas proudly served in the United States Air Force after WWII from 1947-1949 and received an honorable discharge.

Cas worked as a Typesetter at the Muskogee Phoenix News Paper from 1949-1977. He also was a salesman and manager at Montgomery Ward's Retail Store. Cas was the owner of Shopper Advertiser from 1979-1993. He retired from Liggett & Myers INC. and later he went into a partnership with his brother Keith, and they owned Walters Salvage Yard & Auto Complex in 1997.

Cas was a Master Mason, 32 degree Mason, and Shriner. He was of the Baptist faith and was the choir leader at Southeast Baptist Church from 1961-1967 and later at Meadow Brook Baptist Church from 1993-1997. He played the trumpet and guitar and was a very talented vocalist. Cas was presently a member of Shawnee Church of God in Muskogee, Oklahoma. He loved to build replicas of cars, ships, airplanes, and dollhouses.

Cas was preceded in death by his parents Cas William Walters, Sr. and Lois Thelma (Clopton) Walters; and daughter, Donna Hayes.
