Chalmer Darrell Lett, of Fort Gibson, Oklahoma passed away Sunday, June 2, 2013 at the age of 77. He was born on March 28, 1936 in Picher, Oklahoma to Chalmer Carl Lett and Maxine Harbeston Lett. Darrell attended Goodman Public Schools in Missouri and graduated high school with the class of 1954. He married the love of his life, Patty Bassett, on May 21, 1955 in Goodman, Missouri.
