



## Charles Lindy Stevenson

February 28, 1929 - August 15, 2013

Charles Lindy Stevenson, 84, passed away suddenly Thursday evening, August 15, 2013, at Hillcrest Hospital in Tulsa. Lindy was born on February 28, 1929 in Webbers Falls, Oklahoma to Cleo Stevenson and Bess (Johnson) Stevenson. He grew up and attended school at Webbers Falls and graduated from High School with the Class of 1948.
