Charles Howard Stump, 83, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on Sunday, February 20, 2022. He was born on August 26, 1938 in Vancouver, Washington to Jackson Wilber Stump and Ruth Viola (Brandaberry) Stump. He grew up in Anchorage, Alaska, and in 1960 graduated from The University of Alaska in Fairbanks obtaining his bachelor's degree. He furthered his education and obtained his master's degree at Texas A&M. Chuck was in the Civil Air Patrol during high school where he met his future wife, Alice Ann (Lewis) Stump. They were married on July 25, 1959 in Anchorage, Alaska. They shared many years of life, marriage and family together.

Chuck served in the United States Air Force as a pilot during the Vietnam War and received an honorable discharge.
