Christopher Cartright, 37 of Muskogee, passed away Monday, January 12, 2015. "Chris", as his family and friends knew him by, was born July 20, 1977 in Roseville, California to Max Evan Cartright and Susan J. (Blondoff) Cartright-Hunter.
