Dale Wayne Patterson passed from this life on Friday, December 12, 2014 at the age of 55. A few days prior to his passing, Dale chose to accept the eternal gift of being saved by his close friend and pastor, Cardell Coppin. They were joined in marriage on January 19, 1979 at the Freewill Baptist Church in Keefeton, OK. They shared more than 35 years of marriage. From this marriage they were blessed with two children.

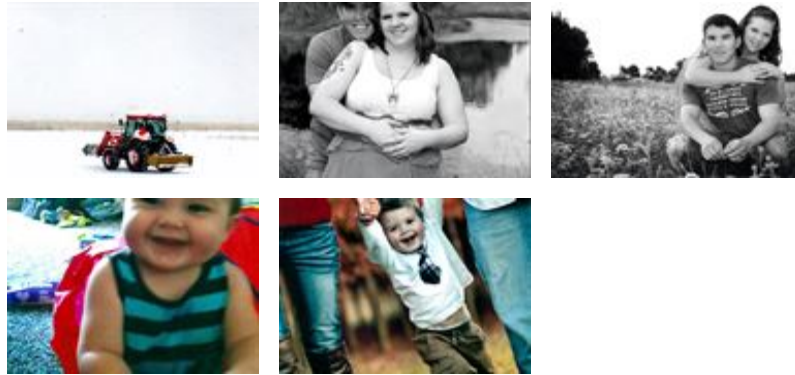
