She attended school at Hilldale Public Schools and enjoyed playing softball. She graduated from Warner High School, and later from Northeastern State University with her bachelor's degree in early childhood education.

Dana enjoyed 35 years of marriage to the love of her life, Joe Croftcheck, who she married on November 11, 1988, at Keefeton Trinity Baptist Church. During her teaching career, Dana taught at Muskogee County Headstart, then at Hilldale Elementary School where she considered it a privilege to "Educate the World" and to show the children about life, usually having a class pet, to help teach the children about responsibility and caring for one another. Dana was a member of Keefeton Trinity Baptist Church where she came to know Jesus as her Savior. Dana had a deep love for her Lord and Savior. She spent many summers organizing and directing Vacation Bible School. She enjoyed watching the kids learning about Jesus and enjoying all the fun and games. Dana and Joe spent time developing the youth group at Keefeton Trinity, taking them to the Falls Creek Youth Camp, to the Youth Evangelism Conferences, and encouraging them at weekly devotional times. Dana and Joe enjoyed working with the youth of Keefeton Trinity and seeing them developing into Christian Leaders.

The joy of Dana's life was her family. In May of 1989, Dana and Joe welcomed their son, Colten Chase, "Her Bouncing Baby Boy" who she adored. She loved spending time with him – watching him play sports – baseball, football, weightlifting; out riding ATVs or swimming; even just checking the cows. She loved watching him grow into a loving father and Christian husband to Laci K who she adored as a daughter that she never had.

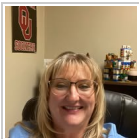

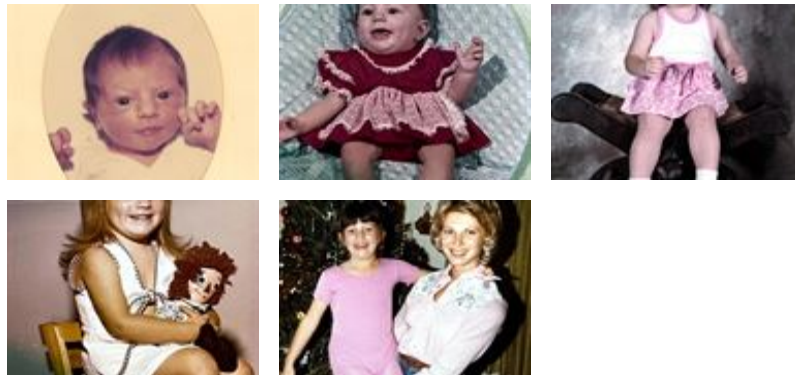
