Daniel “Buck” Lee Ashwood Sr, 86, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Friday, February 23, 2024 with his loving family at his side. He was born September 5, 1937 in Muskogee to Harry Monroe Ashwood Jr and Dorcas Mae (Scroggins) Ashwood.

Buck married the love of his life, Johnnie Geraldine Webster, on December 29, 1956 in Muskogee. They shared more than 64 years of life, marriage and memories together until Johnnie passed away on November 11, 2020.

He worked for many years as a heavy equipment operator in the construction industry and retired 2003.
