David Franklin Moore Jr., 77, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on February 5, 2026 surrounded by his 5 children. He was born on September 1, 1948 to David Franklin Moore Sr. and Mary Eunice (Sullivan) Moore in Columbus, Mississippi. He attended Greenwood Public Schools in Greenwood, Mississippi and Columbus Public Schools in Columbus, Mississippi.

David married the love of his life, September 10, 1966 at the United Methodist Church in Columbus, Mississippi. They would have been married 50 years in the year of her passing June 23, 2016.

David only had 6 jobs in his 77 years, with his first job at the Burger Chef as a carhop. The second job was at the Texaco Gas Station. After that he worked as a semi driver for Tuggle, then Daniels Construction. Daniels Construction moved David and Debbie's family to Muskogee, Oklahoma to start building on the new paper mill, Fort Howard. After the paper mill was completed, he was hired as a millwright to what is now Georgia Pacific, where he retired after 40 years of service.

He was a die-hard OU Boomer Sooner Fan and watched every game. He also attended several home games every single year. He also deeply loved his Weenie dogs, Buddy and Ruby.

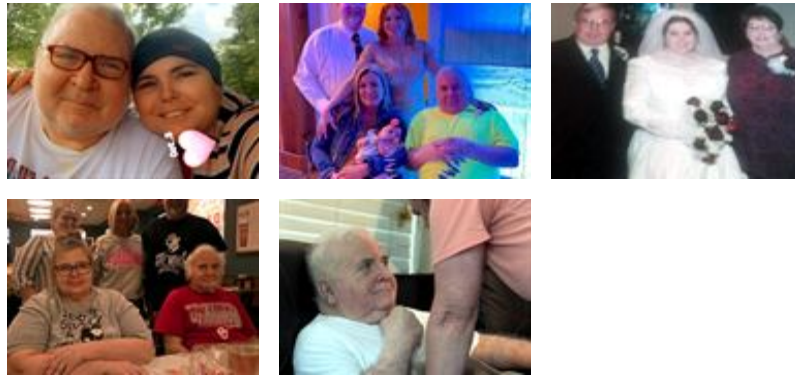

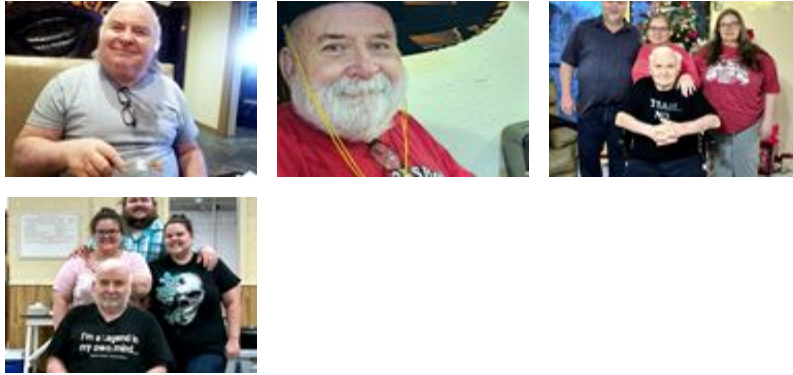

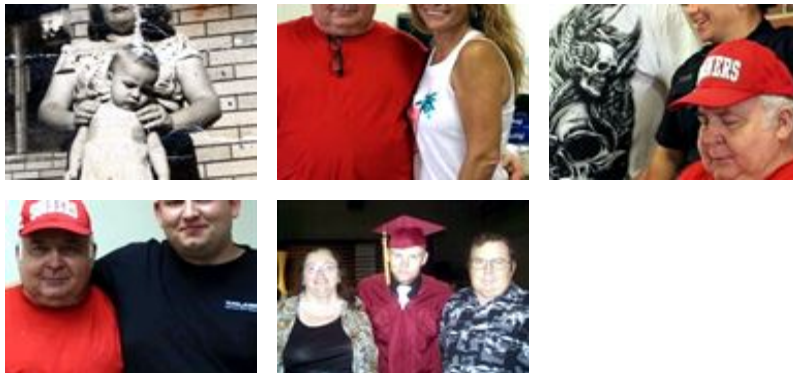
