David Howard Morrow, 88, of Tulsa, Oklahoma passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 13, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. 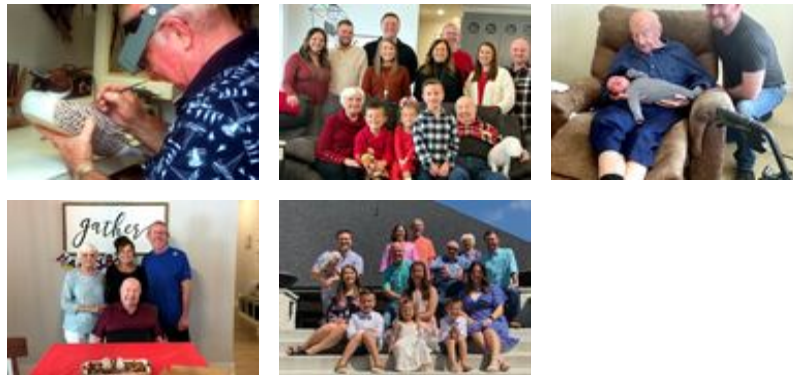
