Deborah "Debbie" Hix, 67 of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on Tuesday, June 18, 2019. She was born on November 27, 1951 to Donley Wayne and Mary Alice (Strayhorn) Lowe in Watonga, Oklahoma. Debbie graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1970. She went on to Oklahoma State University and obtained her Bachelor's Degree of science in home economics in 1974. She also went to Northeastern State University and obtained her Master's Degree of Education and Master's Degree in School Counseling.

Debbie married the love of her life, Winston Bruce Hix, on December 29, 1972 at Bacone Chapel in Muskogee, Oklahoma. They shared over 46 years of life and marriage together.

She worked at Fort Gibson Public Schools from 1977-1990 as a kindergarten teacher. In 1990, Debbie began her career at Muskogee Public Schools as an elementary school counselor and retired in 2013. 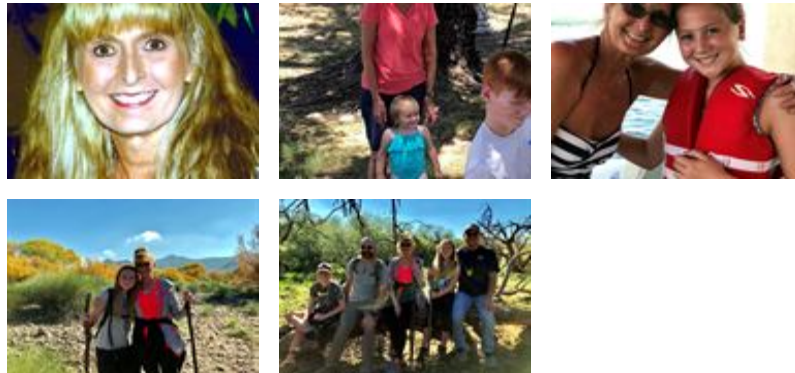
