Donald Gene “Don” Foreman, 77, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away on Thursday, February 1, 2024. He was born on December 4, 1946 to Robert L. Foreman and Loretta (Garrett) Foreman in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Don graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1966. He went on to attend Northeastern State University where he obtained his Master of Science degree in 1995.

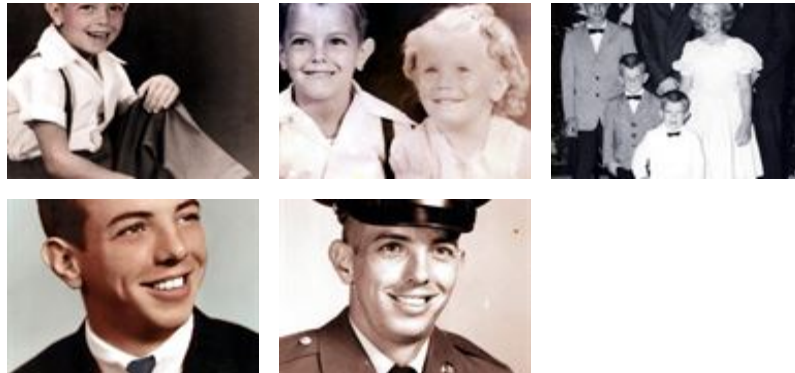
