Holloway was always special to her. She was blessed with many special, long lasting friendships during the years she was there.

After Doris and Tom moved to Muskogee, they became very active in Memorial Christian Church. Doris served in many capacities but especially enjoyed the areas where she could be creative. Her faith and celebration of life experienced with friends there was very important in her life.

Doris served on the board of Muskogee Cooperative Ministries in charge of the Weather Coalition providing fans and air conditioners during the summer and heaters and blankets during the winter.
