Dr. Gideon M. Sein, M.D. , 73, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Monday, January 25, 2016.

He was born February 10, 1942 in Patheingyi Burma in southeast Asia to Dr. Saw Maung Sein and

Daw Kyi Byu. Gideon graduated from the University of Rangoon in Burma with a Medical

Degree and furthered his studies at the University of London in England where he received his

Master's Degree in Pharmacology. He enjoyed his work teaching students at the University of

Rangoon, University of Hong Kong, Connors State College and Bacone College.

Gideon met and later married the love of his life, Pauline (Khin Sandar), on April 20, 1974 in

Rangoon Burma. They shared more than 41 years of life and marriage together.

Gideon was a member and an Elder of Boulevard Christian Church. He also served as a member

of Muskogee Cooperative Ministries. He enjoyed golfing, painting, and listening to jazz music.

Gideon was loved by many and will be truly missed.

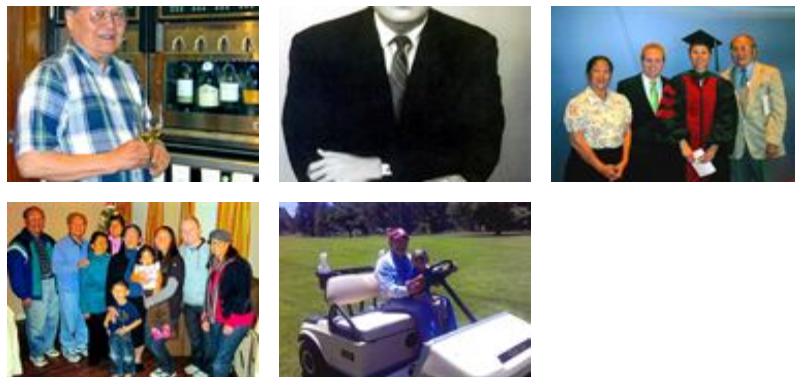
