Eddie Sacks, 51, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Thursday, June 6, 2024 with his loving family at his side. He was born July 12, 1972 in Tahlequah, Oklahoma to Charley Cherokee and Sharon Kay (Pathkiller) Sacks. Eddie attended public schools and graduated from Vian High School with the class of 1990.
