Edgar James Robinson, 66 of Muskogee, passed away Friday, October 16, 2015, surrounded by his family. He was born March 13, 1949, in Hahira, GA to Joseph and Flonnie (Harris) Robinson. He grew up and attended the public schools in Hahira, GA and graduated from Lowndes High School in Valdosta, GA in 1967. After graduation, he worked in Georgia before going to work with family in Oklahoma.

E.J., a nickname that all his family and friends knew him by, worked at Georgia-Pacific for over 27 years, where he was a Pulp Processor. After retiring from Georgia-Pacific, he worked with Meals On Wheels and at Dillard's in the shoe department.

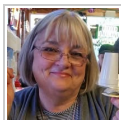
