Edward D. Farris, 90, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones. Born on September 25, 1934, in Savanna-McAlester, Edward was the son of Nugent Farris and Alta Farris. He graduated from Savanna-McAlester Public Schools and went on to earn his Master's degree from Southeastern Oklahoma State University in Durant, Oklahoma. A proud veteran of the United States Air Force, Edward dedicated much of his life to serving others. He worked as a Personnel Officer for the Bureau of Indian Affairs and also contributed to the education of young minds as a substitute teacher. His sense of duty, service, and leadership was evident in every facet of his life. On August 19, 1961, Edward married the love of his life, Patsy Ann Hodge, in Maysville, Oklahoma. Together they built a life centered around faith, family, and community. He was preceded in death by his parents, Nugent Farris and Alta Farris-Migdat; his brother, Marvin Farris; and his sister, Mamie Ruth Farris. Edward Farris will be remembered for his steadfast faith, his generous spirit, and the
