Ed H. Coachman III, 70, was born in Tampa, FL. on December 4, 1941 and passed away in Muskogee, OK. on December 5, 2011.

Ed grew up in Muskogee attending Muskogee Schools and Okmulgee Tech. In the 60's, he worked as a welder on oil rigs in the gulf, was part owner in the Car Clinic in downtown Muskogee, and also served as an Air Force Reserve at Davis Field. In the 70's, he built drive-in's for Sonic until buying his first truck and going on the road. Later during the 90's he worked with his son in California operating dredging equipment. In the mid 90's he returned to Muskogee and drove for Arrow Trucking Heavy Haul Division up until his retirement. Ed loved riding his motorcycle, watching drag racing (John Force) and NCIS.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother Dr. Ed H. Coachman and Dorothy G. Coachman; and brother, Don Coachman.

Ed is survived by his son, Edwin H. Coachman IV (Shawanna and Lillian Pinner) of Muskogee, Edwin's mother, Charlotte Coachman of Port Angels, Wa; sister and brother in law, Anne & Jim Watson of Tulsa; and several nieces and nephews.
