



Eugene Ray Frazier

November 5, 1924 - August 14, 2023

Eugene “Gene” Ray Frazier, 98, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Monday, August 14, 2023. He was born November 5, 1924 in Council Hill, Oklahoma to Thaddeus Garland and Vera (Brown) Frazier. Gene attended school at Lone Star and Oktaha.

On July 12, 1943, Gene became a member of the United States Navy, proudly serving during WW II. He received an honorable discharge after 2 years, 9 months and 8 days of service.

He met and later married Juanita June Elam on January 10, 1948 in Muskogee, Oklahoma. They shared many happy years of life, marriage and memories together.

He worked as a draftsman for Muskogee Iron Works and later for Tulsa Steel Plant retiring in 1986.

Gene was a long-time member of York Street Christian Church. He belonged to a group of men who were on his last ship assignment in the Navy, the USS Flint. They had a reunion every year until there were only 4 of them left.

He enjoyed spending time with his family along with working sudoku, crossword puzzles and woodwork.

He was preceded in death by his parents, T. G. and Vera Frazier; his wife, Juanita; his siblings, T. G. Frazier Jr, Bobby Dean Frazier, Juanita V. Elam, Barbara Aileen Overturf and Shirley Lou Rhinehart.

Gene is survived by his son, James A. Frazier of Philadelphia, PA; daughter, Debbie Allen and husband Jerry of Vian, OK; grandson, Matthew P. O’Brien

and wife Suzy; great-grandson, Timothy N. O'Brien, all of Peoria, AZ; sisters, Alice Ruth Hanson of Stigler, OK and Linda Sue Dawson of Haskell, OK; and his brother, Loyd Ralph Frazier of Arlington, VA; along with numerous nieces, nephews, and other family members.

Gene's life will be remembered at 10AM, Tuesday, August 22, 2023 at Memorial Park Cemetery with Rev. Gene Thompson officiating. Military honors will be presented.
