Evelyn Rose McConnell, 88, of Glenpool, Oklahoma, entered Heaven on Friday, January 23, 2026, surrounded by her loving family.

Above all else, Evelyn loved her family. She was the heart of generations, always welcoming, always giving, and always happiest when everyone was together. Her steady love, her bright laugh, and the home she built that drew her family close will be remembered always.

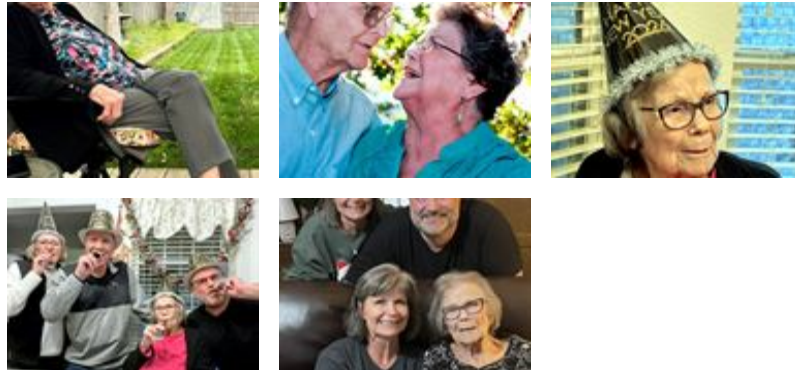
