



Floretta L. Leatherman

August 31, 1939 - May 23, 2020

Floretta LaViana (Reheard) Leatherman, a lifetime resident of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed on Saturday, May 23, 2020 at the age of 80. She was born August 31, 1939 at the Baptist Hospital in Muskogee to Billy Z. and Virginia (Allen) Reheard.

Floretta married the love of her life and best friend, Robert Lloyd “Bob” Leatherman on March 25, 1955, at the home of Rev. Shoemaker in Stigler, Oklahoma. They shared more than 46 years of life, marriage, and memories.

She was the owner of Floretta Leatherman Real Estate and Tax Services along with her husband Bob, who owned and operated Bob’s Office Machines. Floretta was actively involved and supported many community activities. She made angel food cakes for Muskogee FFA pie auctions for 50+ years and was inducted as a Muskogee FFA honorary member in 2000. She was an active member of local and national VFW ladies auxiliaries, the Rebecca’s, served on the election board, Muskogee County PARB board, a member of Eastern Oklahoma Woodcarvers Association, and the Muskogee Genealogical Society. She also played an active role, for over 30 years, at Memorial Day services held at cemeteries.

Floretta was a member of Meadowbrook Baptist Church.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Bob; and daughter, Jeanetta Lynn Leatherman Lane.
