Floyd Collins Rowe, 91, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Monday, May 21, 2018. He was born October 18, 1926 to Robert Franklin Rowe and Flossie Kindrick Rowe in Gore, Oklahoma.

He graduated from Gore High School. He also graduated from Plumbing School in Kansas City, Missouri. Floyd served in the United States Army during World War II.

Floyd was married to Nona Ruth Adams from June 1, 1946 until her death on August 2, 1992.

He married Eldee Durossette on November 30, 1998 in Las Vegas, Nevada. Upon his marriage to Eldee, he gained a son, John Standridge; daughter-in-law, Soozie; grandchildren, Joshua, Cheyenne, and Lucas; and later a great-granddaughter, Paisley, as Eldee's family became his family.

Floyd was a plumber by trade. He worked many years for Hogle Plumbing Company until his retirement. He also taught plumbing and welding classes in Muskogee.

He attended and served in the Baptist Church for many years. He was also a Sunday School teacher.

Floyd believed in hard work and in developing talents. The Bible was important to him and he strived to pattern his life after the teachings of Jesus Christ. He spoke of the parable of the talents found in Matthew 25:14-20.

Floyd believed that everyone receives talents and will be held accountable for the use or misuse of them. He continued throughout his life working and

developing his talents.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Flossie Rowe; first wife, Nona Adams Rowe; sisters, Juanita Ballew, Vivian Stewart, Norma Osborn, and Virginia Anthony; two brothers, Robert Rowe Jr and Mitchell Rowe; sisters-in-law, Marceline Anthony Rowe, Doris Gates Rowe, Martha Henry Rowe; brothers-in-law, Robert Stewart, W.F. 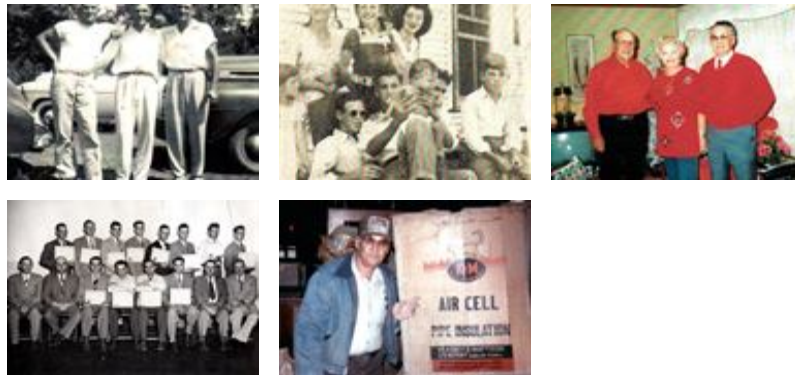
