Floyd William Thompson of Muskogee, Oklahoma formerly of Electra, Texas passed away Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at the age of 80. He was born September 15, 1934 in Fisk, Missouri to Jacob Floyd Thompson and Effie Marie Parkins Thompson. Floyd attended Poplar Bluff High School where he enjoyed playing sports, especially basketball. He met Mary Lois Brady and knew she was the one for him.
