Frank Delmedico, 87, of Tahlequah, Oklahoma, entered his Heavenly home on Monday, January 20, 2020. He was born October 17, 1932 in Fort Gibson, Oklahoma to Veto and Rose Delmedico. Frank attended Fort Gibson Public Schools from which he graduated and furthered his education at Muskogee Junior College.

He proudly served his country as a member of the United States Army during the Korean War and received an honorable discharge.

Frank married the love of his life, Fannie Lee Ellis on August 22, 1953. They shared more than 66 years of life and marriage together.

Frank worked in the sheet metal industry over 55 years where he made many friends and customers. He owned and operated Eastern Sheet Metal beginning in 1971 until his retirement in 2013.

Frank and Fannie were former members of Boston Avenue Baptist Church and have been members of Crescent Valley Baptist Church since 1964 where they both faithfully attended and served in many areas of the church.
