Nick Vann passed away on Saturday, August 6, 2022 in Tulsa, OK. He was born September 5, 1962 in Muskogee, OK to Jean Ward Vann and Enos Nicholson Vann. Nick graduated from Muskogee High School, in 1980. He was an all-around athlete with an unyielding passion to win. As a team leader, he excelled on the Rougher gridiron as the starting quarterback. He followed a rich family tradition by attending OSU Stillwater where he was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity and a loyal and true Cowboys fan. He also attended NSU Tahlequah where he received a B.A. in Business Management. A gifted musician, he played lead electric guitar for the local band 17B. This outstanding band was gaining momentum and had the privilege to open for the Cory Hart concert held at NSU.

Nicky loved his children and his family, they held the most prominent place in his heart. He had an ever-tender heart, with kind and compassionate ways. He easily made new friends wherever he was; Nick's friends always received a hug or a hand shake. His sense of humor and ability to see the joyful and comedic side of life is reminiscent of his father.

Following college, he was a licensed commodities broker for Barnes Brokerage in Edmond. He went on to spend most of his career in sales and marketing with Royal Casket Company. Being raised a Christian, Nick

attended church regularly and was baptized at the First Baptist Church in Muskogee.

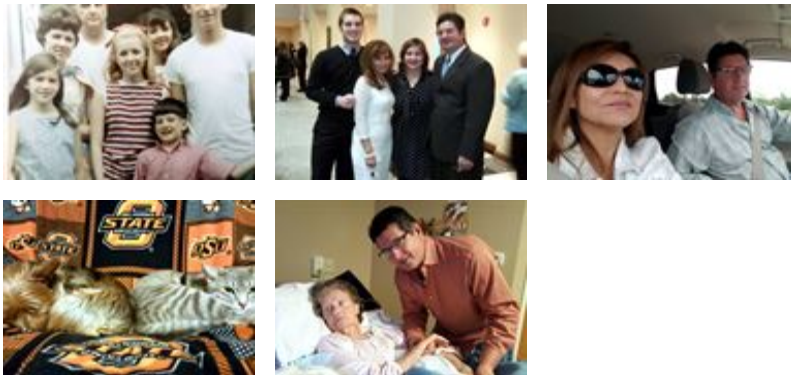
