Garrett Lambert Hotema, 40, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Friday, April 19, 2024. He was born January 4, 1984 in Gallup, New Mexico to Benny Rae and Bessie (Charley) Hotema. He spent his early years in Chinle, Arizona and later moved with his family to Muskogee. He attended Muskogee High School from August 2000 to September 2001. He returned to Chinle and graduated in 2003 from Chinle High School. Garrett furthered his education at Diné College in Tsaile, AZ, Connors State College and Bacone College.

He worked for Creek Nation Casino from 2005-2010. He was a jack of all trades; working as a bartender, cashier, babysitter, along with other occupations.

Garrett's hobbies included beadwork, drawing, coloring, raising his kittens and dog. He loved spending time with his family and his partner.

He will be dearly missed.

Garrett is survived by his father, Benny Hotema; his sister, Benita Hotema and husband Juan Becerra, all of Muskogee; his niece, Valencia Jasmine Rodriguez; his nephews, Jose Alberto Rodriguez and Victor Julio Hotema, all of Muskogee, and Benito Sol-Gabriel Rodriguez of Salt Lake City, UT; his partner, Jeffrey Walter Hillhouse of Muskogee; his furbabies, 4 cats, Mork, Peaches, Molly, and Striker and 1 dog, Nona.
