Gary Lesteen Armstrong, 81, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed from his earthly life to his Heavenly home on Friday, August 2, 2024. He was born May 5, 1943 in Marlow, Oklahoma to Ivan Lesteen and Jane Ellen (Rollins) Armstrong. He attended public school and graduated from El Reno High School with the class of 1961.

Gary proudly served his country as a member of the United States Army during the Vietnam era. He received a good conduct medal and a letter of commendation for exemplary performance of duty. He received an honorable discharge in 1965.

He furthered his education at Southwestern College in Weatherford, Oklahoma obtaining his bachelor's degree in 1968.

Gary married the love of his life, Mary Beth Patterson on January 24, 1970 in Manitou, Oklahoma. They shared more than 54 years of life, marriage, and memories together.

He worked as a medical technologist at the VA hospital and Muskogee Regional Hospital.

Gary and Mary were owners of Club Lunch in downtown Muskogee for over 36 years. They made many great friendships and acquaintances over the

years along with wonderful memories.

Gary was a longtime member of Muskogee First Baptist Church where he faithfully attended and served as a deacon. He was a member of the Republican Club and Antique Club. He loved collecting antiques, especially telephones.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Ivan and Jane Armstrong; brother, Martin Armstrong; in-laws, Vivian and Beatty Patterson; and brother-in-law, Ray Patterson.

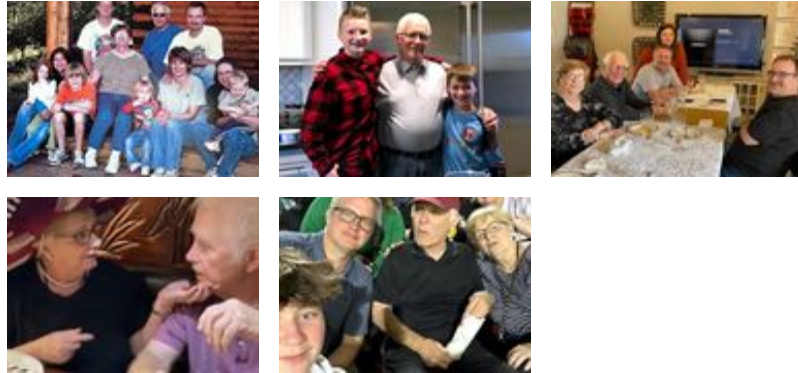

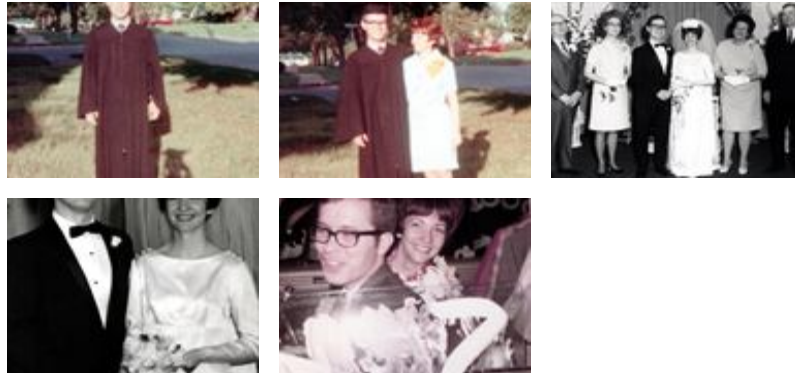
