Geraldine "Jeri" Leep, 82, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 26, 2025. Born to Walter Lee and Alice Pearl (Hutching) Holland in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, Jeri lived a life full of love, hard work, and dedication to her family and community.

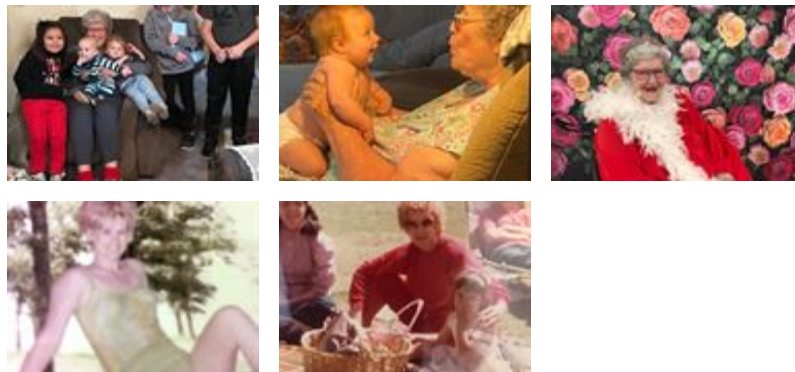

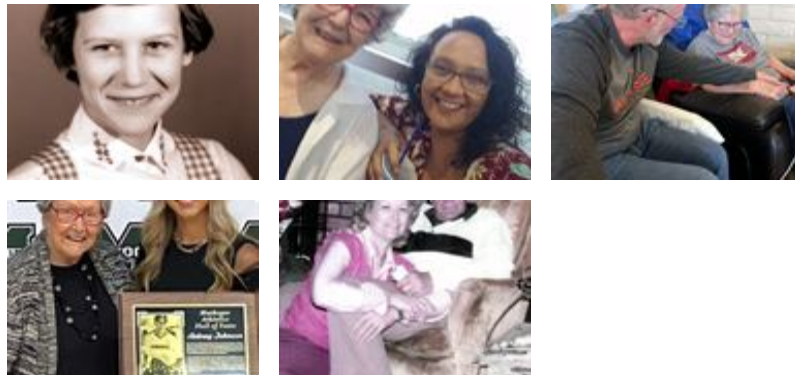
