



## Glen Dean Andrews

August 6, 1930 - February 28, 2012

Glen Dean Andrews, 81 years old, resident of Muskogee, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, February 28, 2012. He was born on August 6, 1930 in Watts, OK to Henry Lee and Nancy Clementine Baker Andrews. His parents had moved from Dyer, AR to Watts, OK in 1928, then to Checotah, OK in 1933 and on to Muskogee in 1940. Glen grew up in Checotah and Muskogee. On July 27, 1949, he married the love of his life, Myrtle Irene Nolen Rainey, in Van Buren, AR. They made their home in Muskogee where they have resided ever since.

Glen worked his entire career for Oklahoma Gas and Electric in Muskogee, retiring in 1985 after 39 years of service. Daddy enjoyed being with his family and friends, going to races, fishing and camping. He was always involved with his son's racing, from working on the race cars or driving to different tracks, he was always there to help them race. Most importantly, Daddy accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior on March 25, 1951 at Immanuel Baptist Church. Beginning at that point, he began serving his Lord as a Sunday School teacher, Sunday School director, and usher. Daddy spent his life taking care of his family, always being attentive to anything that was needed, especially to Mom. They shared 62 wonderful years together.
