Glen Dale Faith, 78, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, April 8, 2014 at his home. He was born January 9, 1936 in High Hill, Oklahoma to John E. Faith and Ora Mae (Serber) Faith. Glen grew up and attended the first through eighth grade at High Hill School in High Hill, Oklahoma. He graduated from Haileyville High School in 1954.
