Glenda "Faye" Bemo, 86, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away Sunday, October 13, 2024 surrounded by her loving family. She was born November 12, 1937 in Oktaha, Oklahoma to Glenn L and Edna L (Beaver) Elam. Faye attended Oktaha schools and graduated from Oktaha High School with the class of 1955.

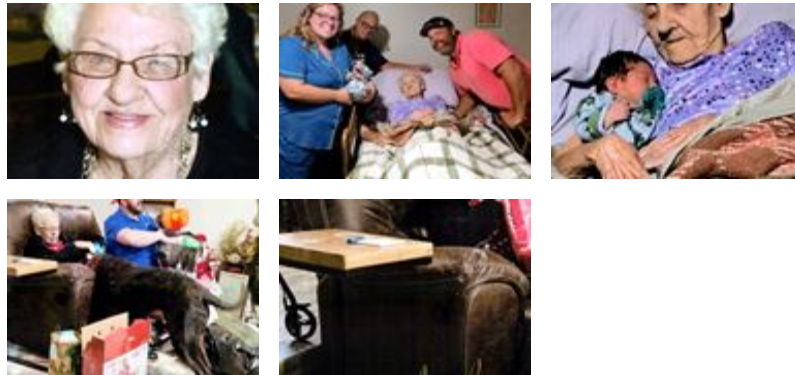
