January 5, 1941 - March 23, 2023

Glenda Fay Nickel, 82, of Park Hill, Oklahoma passed away Thursday, March 23, 2023. She was born January 5, 1941 in Sallisaw, Oklahoma to David and Martha (Day) Stark. After moving to Muskogee with her family she attended Hyde Park Country School during her first through six grade; Alice Robertson Jr High School for seventh through ninth grade; and Central High School for tenth through twelfth grade. She graduated in 1959. Glenda furthered her education at Bacone College where she was valedictorian and then Northeastern State University where she received her bachelor of science degree and a masters degree in reading.
