Glenn Allen Carrell Sr., 76, of Gore, Oklahoma passed away on Sunday, May 18, 2025. He was born February 18, 1949 to Earl R. Carrell and Jane Katherine Daniels in Muskogee, Oklahoma. He graduated from Muskogee Central High School with the class of 1968.

He joined the United States Army in 1969 and proudly served two tours in Vietnam. He was awarded a Bronze Star, Air Medal and Army Commendation. 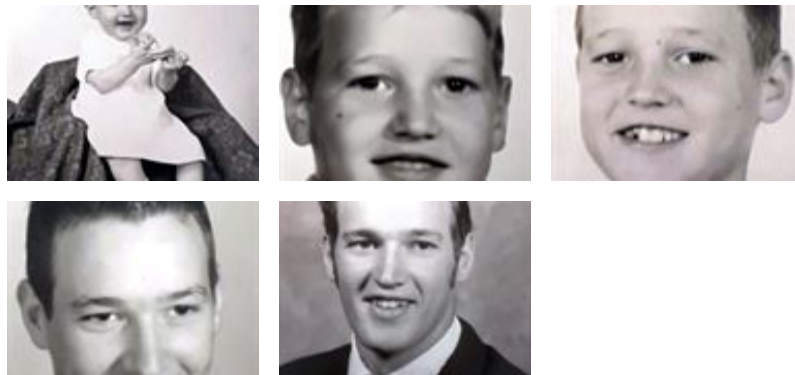
