Gloria Doris Schumann passed away at the age of 91 at her home on Wednesday, February 22, 2012. She was born October 10, 1920 in White Plains, NY to Charles W. Schumann and Marie Antoinette Coellen Schumann. Early in Gloria's childhood, her grandfather, the well-known collector, Charles William Schumann, inspired her love for painting. Gloria and her mother visited Europe frequently. She attended both private and public schools in the U.S. and abroad. Having exposure to such cultures and societies, Gloria learned to speak French, German, and English. She married Monty Maduria who preceded her in death in 1953.

She studied art under the gifted Belgian-American portraitist, Louise Altson, in New York that further developed her talent and skill in becoming a world renowned portraitist. Gloria noted that Louise made a comment that changed her life forever, "Gloria, if God gives you a talent, you should honor it." She never forgot that statement and honored it till the end.

Gloria inspired many artists by telling them if they wanted to be truly successful they needed to put "God" in their painting.

Gloria had a great love for Oklahoma. She was fascinated with the wide open view of the sky, the many rivers and beautiful countryside; which are a few of the many reasons she chose to make Muskogee her home.

Gloria was a unique individual. She was surrounded by people who grew to love her and took care of her. Her two loyal friends, Tracy Hoos and Ginger Dunn were among those who gave her excellent care. Her employees

became her friends. A special thanks to Fetna, Norma, Zelma, Audrey, Ima, Linda, Kahty, Barbara, and Pat; all who were a blessing to Gloria and received a blessing in return.
