Helen Elizabeth (Cullen) Coppock, 95, of Muskogee, Oklahoma went to be with her Lord and Savior on Tuesday, October 8, 2024. 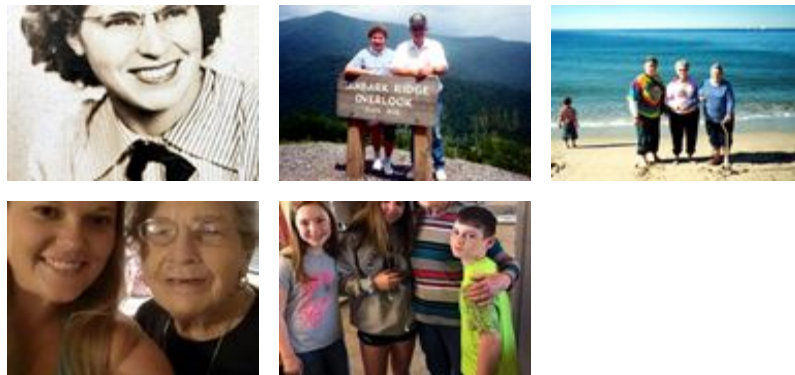
