Helen Faye Timothy, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and great-great grandmother, age 91 of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed peacefully from this life into eternal glory on Sunday morning, October 19, 2025 at her home, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Sentinel, Oklahoma, September 26, 1934, the fourth child of Orville Burton, and Alma Adeline Campbel Burton. Helen attended Oklahoma School for the Blind and was present at the school when a devastating tornado struck the school on April 12, 1945 when she was nine years old.

On June 15, 1954, Helen married John Levi Timothy in Muskogee, Oklahoma. Their years together lovingly produced four children, the oldest lost due to miscarriage. When asked who she wanted to see first when she got to heaven, she stated that she wanted to see her baby first.

Helen was a homemaker for many years. Later in life, she worked for Visual Services through the Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitation until she retired. She made many friends through the years and remembered them all fondly.

“ I sat in the corner tonite at Dad’s, the corner where Mom always sat, where the hospital bed was. So, so, close to where she was just days ago.
