



## Hubert Lee Schaffer

October 22, 1936 - January 13, 2019

Hubert Lee Schaffer, 82, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed from this life on Sunday, January 13, 2019. He was born on October 22, 1936 to Lemuel Schaffer and Thelma Arnold in Blaine County, Oklahoma. He attended high school in Ada, Oklahoma. He graduated from High School and continued his education at East Texas Baptist University, where he graduated in 1962. He married the love of his life Vickye Dunn on September 12, 1967 in Shreveport, Louisiana. They shared more than 51 memorable years together.

Hubert spent most of his life as a pastor. He pastored part-time at Spring Creek Baptist Church, Rolla, MO and at Gasconade Baptist Church, Gasconade, MO. He pastored full-time at High Point Baptist Church, High Point, MO and at Westside Baptist Church, Waynesville, MO, where he retired in 1999. During his lifetime Hubert also served as the Director of Investigation at Missouri Human Rights Commission, as a Pardon and Parole Officer-Felony Division in the city of St. Louis, and at the Missouri Baptist Children's Home. Hubert was also a dedicated member of First Baptist Church in Muskogee.

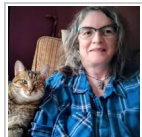
