



Ina Mae Shilling

September 13, 1923 - September 20, 2014

Ina Mae Shilling, 91 of Muskogee, Oklahoma, passed away early Saturday morning, September 20, 2014, at her home surrounded by her family. A longtime resident of Muskogee, Ina Mae was born September 13, 1923 to George Newton Sly and Bessie Alifair (Duffel) Sly in the Yonkers Community of Wagoner County, Oklahoma. Her children remember her telling that when she was born, she was very small and her parents kept her in a shoe box near the stove. She grew up and attended public schools in Muskogee and graduated from Central High School with the class of 1939 when she was only sixteen years old.

After finishing her education, Ina Mae worked with McDonnell Douglas in Tulsa. Her family remembers her reminiscing about while she was working with McDonnell Douglas during World War II, that she was a true-life “Rosie the Riveter.”

On February 12, 1944, Ina Mae married the love of her life, Edward James Shilling at the Salvation Army in Fort Sill, Oklahoma. They shared over 38 years of marriage together.

Ina Mae’s children recall how much she enjoyed being around babies and children. She very much enjoyed her job as a teacher’s aide at Hilldale Elementary School, from which she retired in 2000. Ina Mae also loved to read. She traveled with her family to every state in the United States except for Oregon. She enjoyed trips to the Bahamas, Mexico, Canada and sailed the Chesapeake.

Ina Mae is preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Edward; her daughter, Marsha Nell (Shilling) Moguin, her grandchildren, Matthew Shane Berlin and Bryan Anthony Moguin; her 2 brothers and 1 sister.

She is survived by her children, son and daughter-in-law, James and Linda Shilling of Muskogee, son and daughter-in-law, Gary and Joyce Shilling of Tulsa, daughter and son-in-law, Sheryl and Paul Berlin of Muskogee; her grandchildren, Lisa McGlothlin and husband Ken of Muskogee, Scott Shilling and wife Trish of Omaha, NE, Tonya Bryant and husband Doug of Tahlequah, Kevin Shilling of Tulsa, Casey Berlin of Muskogee, and Jon Moguin of Wainwright; her 6 great grandchildren and her 3 great great grandchildren; other family members and friends.
