Jean Ann Beard, age 93, of Muskogee, Oklahoma passed away in the early morning hours on Wednesday, April 15, 2026. She was born July 18, 1932 in Muskogee; the beloved daughter of John Beatty and Margaret (Wyett) Fink. She grew up in Muskogee and graduated from Central High School in 1950 where she was involved in several groups and clubs, including serving as Class Secretary.

Jean was a Kappa Kappa Gamma at the University of Oklahoma prior to her marriage to John F. Engelbrecht in 1953. He was the love of her life with whom she moved to a few different locations with while he completed his dental degree. Together they had four children, Johnny, Betsy, Tommy, and Mike. After John's dental school graduation, they moved back to Muskogee, eventually buying a home "in the country". After losing John far too early, she went on to finish obtaining her teaching degree and taught at Hilldale Public Schools until retirement. loved every one of them bunches and bunches and bunches more.

She married Charles "Charlie" Beard in December of 1991 with a grandchild clinging to her knee. Together they were members of First Baptist Church for many years and were active in their Sunday School groups. They loved to travel the world, taking cruises, seeing the sights, and always bringing back something for the grandkids. They spent much of their time together in the summers by the pool where Charlie would teach the grandkids to swim and Nana would be making sure everyone was fed with sandwiches and ice cream - and reminding them that reading by the pool was fun.

Jean adored watching her family grow, celebrating their accomplishments, and encouraging their happiness at each and every turn. It was her greatest joy.
