He was 30 years old. Jeff entered into this life on November 29, 1985 to proud parents, Berry and Beverly Harris in Muskogee, OK. Jeff was very intelligent and had many accomplishments. He worked as a paramedic. He was also a licensed electrician and licensed welder. He worked a couple of years doing pipeline welding and pipeline safety officer. Growing up he worked with his dad as an electrician but his passion was being a paramedic where he enjoyed helping others. Jeff excelled at everything he set out to do. He played baseball, football, soccer, golf, and enjoyed riding four wheelers, dirt bikes, and street bikes. Jeff was an avid golfer, receiving a golf scholarship from NSU, after graduating from Ft. Gibson High School in 2004, as an honor student. He lived in Port Saint Lucie, FL for a year and a half working as an electrician before returning home to Muskogee in February of this year, to return to his passion of working on an ambulance.

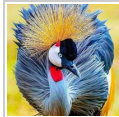

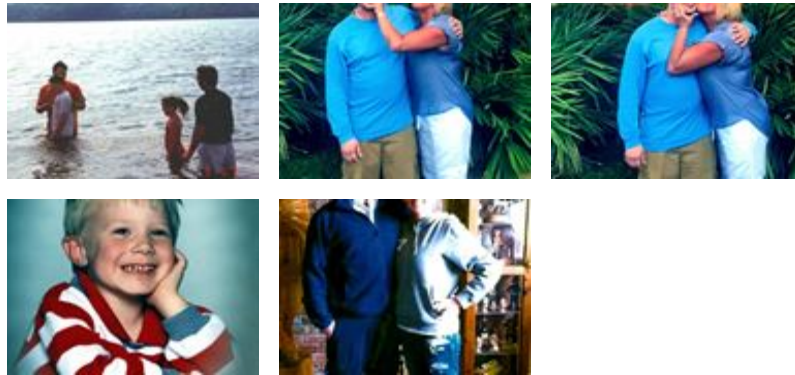
