Jerry Dean Blair, Sr., 82, lifetime resident of Muskogee County, passed away Friday afternoon, April 22, 2016 in Muskogee. He was born September 1, 1933 in Braggs, OK to Coy and Toka (Marshall) Blair. He grew up and attended the public schools in Muskogee and graduated from Central High School with the class of 1950.

After graduation from high school, Jerry enlisted with the United States Army and served his country faithfully for four years in active duty and four years with the Reserves. He received an Honorable Discharge.

Jerry married the love of his life, Elsie Louise "Dolly" West, on May 28, 1971 in Muskogee, OK at the home of a close friend of his family, Rev. Walter Collins. Together they have celebrated almost 45 years of marriage together.
