Jerry Wayne Tye, “Tye Boy” was born on February 5, 1939 in Haskell, Oklahoma. The Lord called him home on July 7, 2022 with his loving daughters by his side. He was the youngest of seven children born to John Pierson (Jake) and Juanita Massey Tye. He grew up in the Choska Bottoms along the Arkansas River where his family farmed land for a share of the crop. His family eventually settled in Muskogee.

A member of the greatest generation, Jerry joined the United States Army on May 24, 1962 where he served for 2 years. He was a radio operator and qualified as expert rifleman, sharpshooter and received a good conduct medal.

Jerry was an avid NASCAR fan; his favorite driver was Richard Petty. He also enjoyed watching OU football with his daughter Jan. He graduated from Central High School in 1958. He was a member of Eastern Heights Baptist Church.

He is preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Gene, Harold and J.R.; and sister, Helen Burns.

Jerry is survived by his two daughters, June Tye and Jan Foster of Muskogee, OK, grandsons, Cody Tye of Fort Gibson, OK and Kevin Tye of Park Hill, OK; great-grandsons, Kyndrix and Grayson Tye of Muskogee, OK; his sisters, Ann Roe of Muskogee and Norma Jo Cutler (husband Don) of Arlington, Texas along with numerous nieces and nephews.
