Joe Rex Davenport, 82, of Warner, Oklahoma passed away Tuesday, September 6, 2011. He was born July 21, 1929 in Hazel, Kentucky to Rexie and Ila Mae (Hutson) Davenport. Joe graduated from Hazel High School in 1947 and later attended Murray State University where he graduated in 1957 obtaining a bachelor's degree. He spent two years in the Army serving as a medic specialist. He was employed by Kerr McGee as a production manager from which he retired in 1986. Joe married the love of his life, Patty Sue Geurin, on August 25, 1956 in Murray, Kentucky. He served on the Warner School Board from 1972 to 1981 and a two year term on the Industrial Chemical Technology Advisory Committee at Eastern Oklahoma State College in Wilburton.

Joe enjoyed golfing, fishing, hunting, gardening, and spending time with his grandchildren and attending his home church, Keefeton Freewill Baptist.

Joe was preceded in death by his parents, Rexie and Ila Mae Davenport.
